B. The Messiah's Birth and Childhood

Ge. 49:10	Timing of birth. According to the Talmud, in about 7 A.D. The Romans removed the power of the Sanhedrin Council in Judah to pronounce the death penalty, thus the sceptre (power) passed from Judah. Jesus had been around 4 B.C. During the reign of Herod (Mt. 2:1), so "Shiloh" (a Messianic title) had come shortly before the sceptre departed, just as prophesied. Also, once the Jews were expelled from the land by the Romans, all semblance of national autonomy under Judah was gone.

Da. 9:25-26 Timing of death. The prophecy states that the Messiah will die 69 weeks of years (483 yrs.) after the edict is issued to rebuild Jerusalem. The edit was issued by Artaxerxes in 445 B.C. And 483 lunar years later Jesus was crucified in Jerusalem.
